Student Expectations

Parents, please read this section with your elementary children to make sure they understand the following expectations. 7th-12th Grade Students are expected to read these expectations on their own.

As a student and participant of Eagle River Homeschool, I agree to the following terms. I agree to:

General Terms

- Show respect for all adults and other students.
- Show respect for all property at any meeting location.
- Be welcoming to other students.
- Be quiet and respectful when using the Study Hall room.
- Walk and use quiet voices while changing classes.
- Follow the dress code.
- Refrain from inappropriate conversations/gestures, explicit/foul language, aggressive physical contact, bullying, teasing, or threatening behavior in order to protect a healthy, enriching environment for all students.
- Refrain from public displays of affection with other students.
- Not bring any drugs or weapons (real or fake) to classes.
- Clean up after myself in class and at lunch.
- Refrain from bringing food containing nuts to class.

Class Time

- Remain in the classroom during class time unless given permission from the teacher to use the restroom.
- Refrain from using electronics in class unless requested by the teacher for an activity.
- Give my attention to teachers and participate in class discussions or projects.
- Bring all required materials to class each day.
- Arrive ON TIME for class.
- Complete all assigned homework and turn in on time.

Payments & Classes -

- Make class payments directly to the teachers by the deadlines (Fall-August 23, 2024 or September 13, 2024 & Spring-January 10, 2025.) Or arrange direct billing through my homeschool charter.
- Drop a class by the drop deadline (Fall-August 23, 2024 or September 13, 2024 & Spring-January 10, 2025.)). I understand if a class is dropped after the drop deadline I will be responsible for the entire semester's tuition.
- Be responsible for gathering work samples and grades and reporting to my homeschool charter (if applicable). I understand teachers will not give grade reports (other than on Google Classroom for 7th-12th grade classes) or share work samples.
- Drop off and pick up students ON TIME for all classes. I recognize this is a drop off program and will NOT wait in the building unless approved by ERH administrators.
